

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Note: Dietitians Association of Australia, trading as Dietitians Australia (DA).

To qualify for early bird registration, registration fees must be paid in full by 12 May 2021. Registration fees received after this date will revert back to the standard conference applicable rate. Registration fees are based on date of payment receipt, not the date of receipt of registration form.

After Friday, 18 June 2021 midnight AEST, only payment made by credit card will be accepted.

The overwhelming importance of the Conference Committee is the health and safety of our delegates, sponsors and exhibitors, your communities and our industry. In the event of travel bans, border closure, restrictions on large gatherings, or other impacts due to Covid-19 pandemic or other conditions, the conference will move from a hybrid event to a virtual conference/congress. By registering to attend, you accept that the date of the conference may change under these conditions.

If moved to virtual only the conference will refund the difference in registration fee between in-person and virtual rates. In the case that the delegate does not wish to attend the Conference virtually, no full refunds will be given, only the difference in the fee will be refunded.

CANCELLATION CONDITIONS

Change from a full registration to virtual registration component only can be accepted if no in-person attendance is possible. The difference between full registration and virtual registration cost will be refunded if advised via email by 18 June 2021.

Cancellations received in writing at the Conference Office by 18 June 2021 will be accepted and all fees refunded less an administrative fee of AUD \$100. Cancellations received after this date cannot be accepted and will not be refunded (in part or full).

If your application for a visa to enter Australia is unsuccessful, the above cancellation terms apply.

Transfer of registration: Transfer of your registration to another person within your organisation is acceptable. The full name and details of the person that will replace you must be advised in writing to the Conference Office prior to the Conference.

Non-attendance: No refunds will be made for non-attendance at the Conference.

Conference Cancellation of the conference by Dietitians Australia or Think Business Events

It may be necessary for reasons beyond the control of Dietitians Australia or Think Business Events to alter the times, dates, itineraries or speakers of the conference by notice to you at any time. In the unlikely event of cancellation of the conference, the maximum liability of Dietitians Australia is the full amount of the refund of the conference registration fee and its associated components of attendance with no additional liability for travel costs, hotel costs, or any other costs or expenses whatsoever.
